### **MARCH FOOD DRIVE IS HERE**

The food drive is Feb. 25 – April 7<sup>th</sup>

This is the largest fundraiser of the year for the pantry. The donations received help us to purchase food for the summer months and into the fall. The state will donate 20% more to the Pantry on the money and food that will be collected in the March Food Drive.

Last year the pantry gave out 341,816 pounds of food to our clients. Each month about 150 families use the Princeton Pantry. 12.5% of the clients served are senior citizens, 34% are children, 53.5% are adults.

The Pantry purchases most of its food from Second Harvest in Grand Rapids. We pay 30 cents a pound for that food. Your money donated to the Pantry will buy more food from Second Harvest, than your purchase of groceries.

## **THE ST. JOHN'S BOYS' CHOIR**

**Renowned Boys' Choir to Visit Immanuel** – The St. John's Boys' Choir (Collegeville, MN) will be presenting a concert of sacred and world music at Immanuel Lutheran Church on Saturday, April 6 at 7:00 pm. Founded by the monks of Saint John's Abbey, the choir has grown over the past four decades to become one of the nation's musical treasures. The choirboys serve as ambassadors for Minnesota and the US, representing state and country at choral festivals and conferences around the world. They have toured throughout Europe, the Americas, and Japan, having performed in venues such as Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris and Sagrada Familia in Barcelona, and will make their Carnegie Hall debut this June. They can be heard on any of several independent-released CDs, as well as
